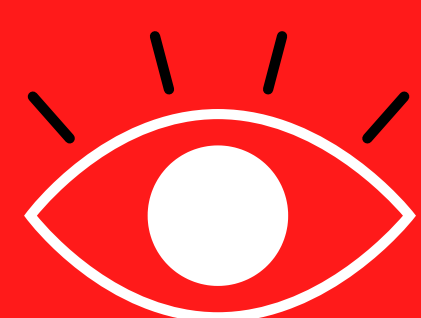

For over **24 years**, we have built a strong reputation for excellence in governance, peacebuilding, and natural resource management through **capacity development** and **grants management**.



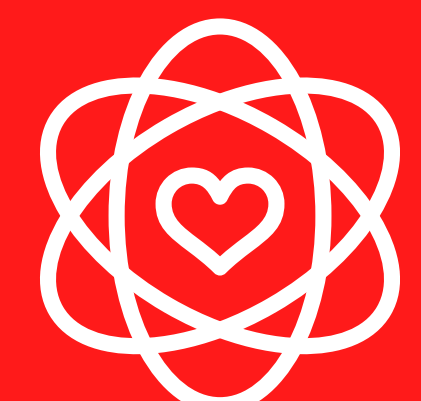

About the Programme

The Reformed Elections for Enhanced Democracy and Inclusion (REDI) Programme is a **3-year initiative (November 2025 – October 2028)** implemented under the Democracy, Governance and Human Rights Platform.

The programme is funded by the Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency (Sida) and will be implemented in partnership with national and county-based civil society organizations (CSOs), in collaboration with relevant institutions at both the national and county levels.

Kenya has made significant democratic gains since the promulgation of the 2010 Constitution and with the 2013 General Election which marked the first national poll conducted under the new constitutional framework. Despite the gains, recent years have seen democratic lapse, declining public trust in key institutions, and shrinking civic space which have contributed to critical challenges that the REDI Programmes seeks to address:

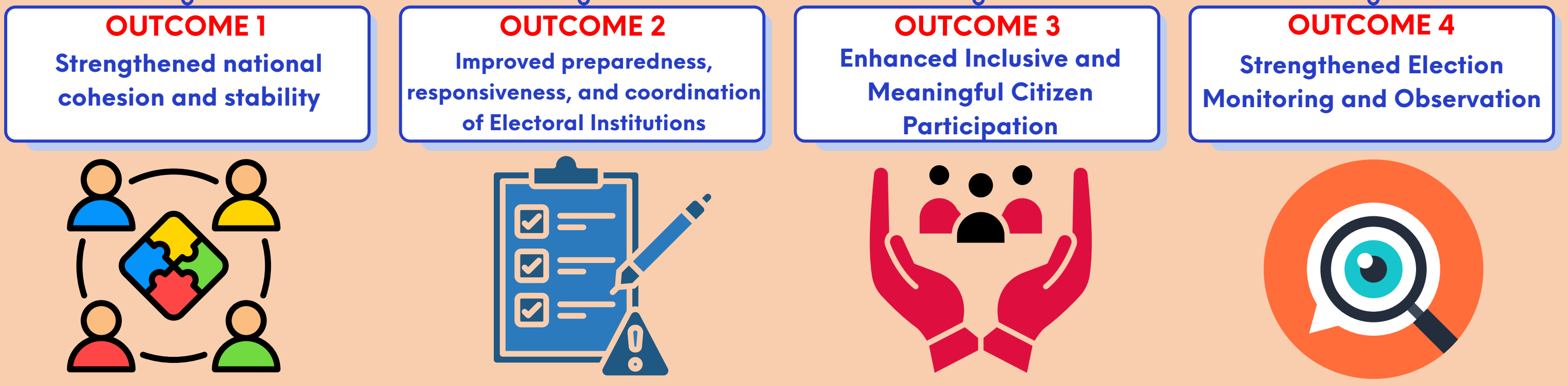

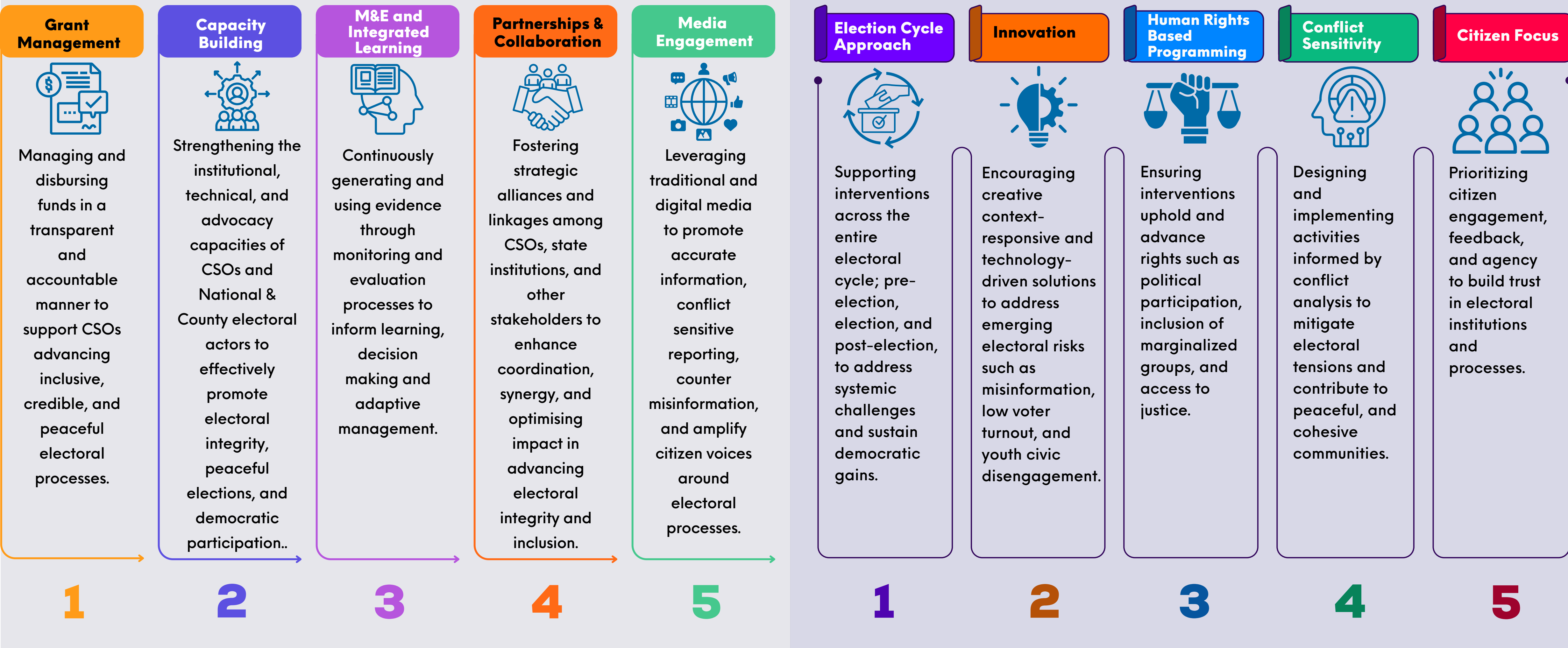
