



# KENYA ELECTORAL CONFLICTS MITIGATION AND CIVIC/VOTER EDUCATION SUPPORT (ECCES) PROGRAM

The ECCES Program supports civil society and youth to successfully participate in democratic processes, lead voter and civic education and implement local strategies to mitigate and prevent electoral violence.

## **Gaps Addressed**

- Elections violence and its impacts on inclusion, participation of women, youth and PWDs as candidates and voters;
- Misinformation, disinformation and withholding of key elections information (political manipulation) critical for effective participation of all eligible citizens as voters and candidates;
- Delayed and sometimes poorly managed voter/civic education that has marginalized youth, women and PWDs as voters/candidates;
- Weak participation of civil society, women and youth in other democratic processes around (pre and post) the elections.

#### **Program Objectives**

Objective 1: Strengthen elections violence mitigation and response

Objective 2: Promote inclusive civil society, youth and women-led voter/civic education

Objective 3: Enhanced participation of youth and women in other democratic processes pre and post general election

Objective 4: Strengthen Capacity of County-based partners for enhanced community resilience and civic/voter education

- Mapping of electoral/political conflict drivers at risk groups
- Early Warning Early Response to electoral/political conflicts
- County/community conversations on peaceful elections and social cohesion
- Rapid response to political conflicts
- Youth, women, PWDs participation in governance processes and local peace processes
- Capacity strengthening of county-based CSOs.
