Vision

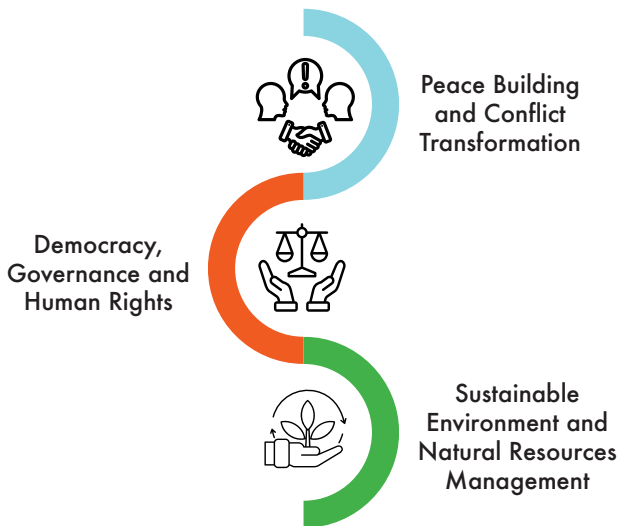

About The KDP Programme

The KDP is a 4-year programme (2021-2025) and is a successor to the Kenya Devolution Support Programme (KDSP) and Agile Harmonized Assistance for Devolved Institutions (AHADI).

KDP – Timiza Ugatuzi will contribute to making devolution more effective in Kenya, with particular emphasis on improving service delivery and accountability.

The overall impact of the Programme is improved development results at the county level. This will be achieved through:

- 1** Technical assistance to county governments and IGR institutions.
- 2** Building capacity of citizens and CSOs for advocacy and engagement with governments in PEM process.
- 3** Entrenching continuous evidence generation, learning and use of digital approaches in service delivery.
- 4** Leveraging capacities, networks and effective coordination while building synergies between KDP and other FCDO investments and priorities.

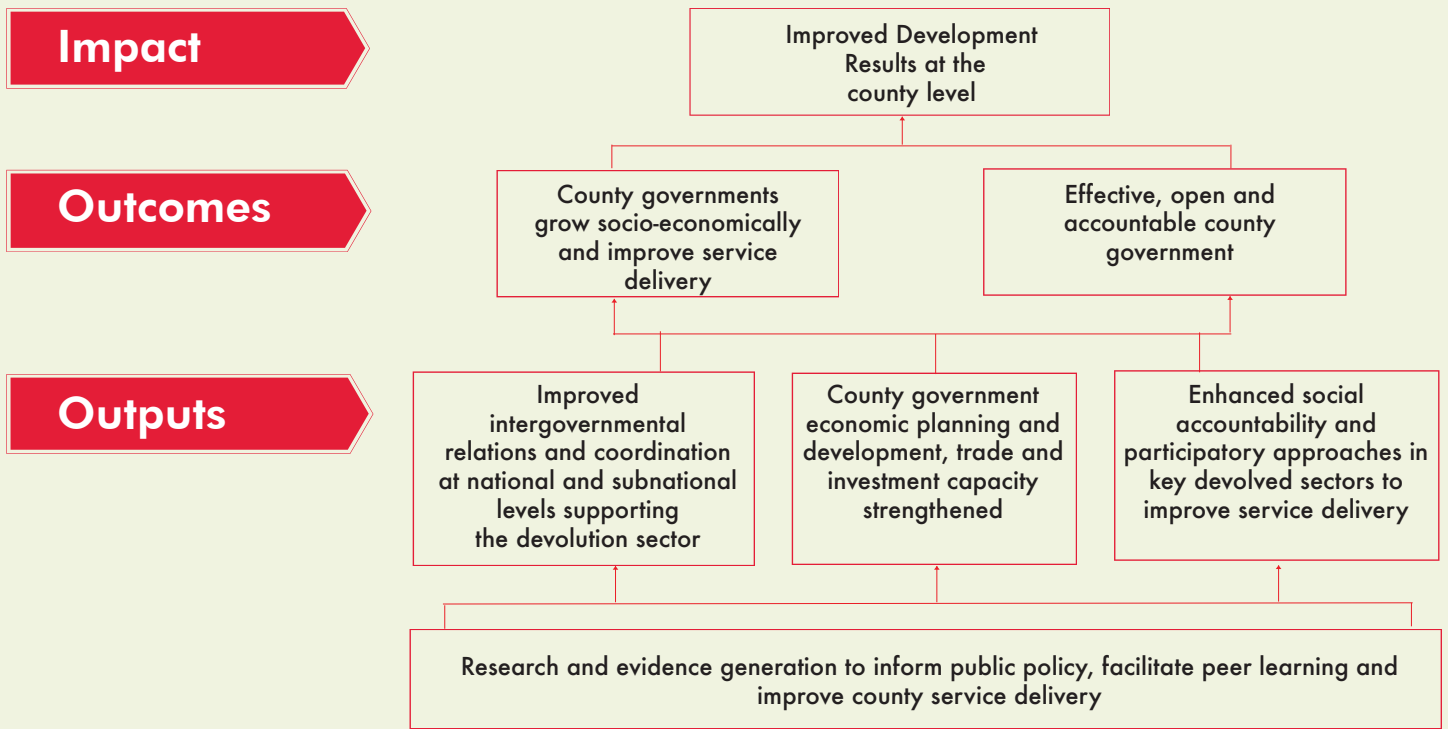

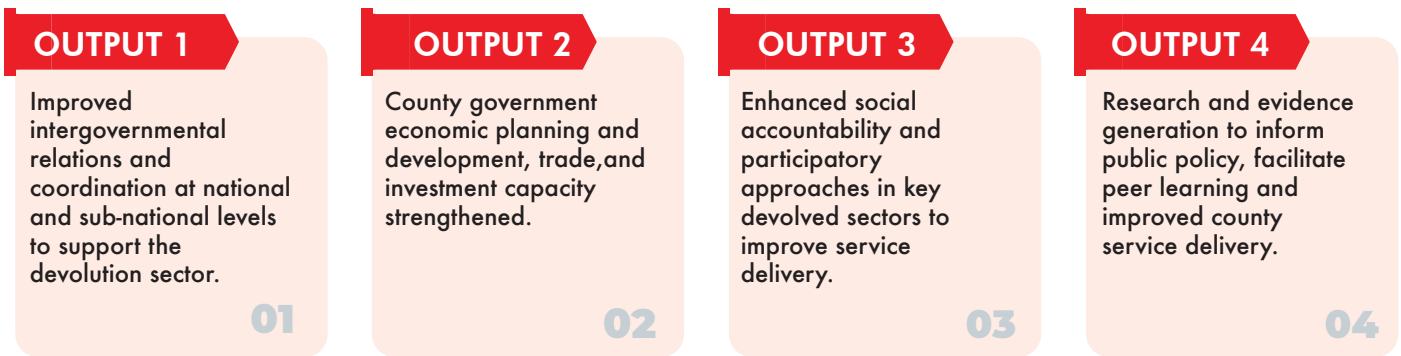
